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Short Report

The Multiplier Event in Spain (E4) took place on 30th April 2022 during the AEI Tèxtils (the cluster of the advanced textile materials in Catalonia) partners' meeting.

In order to engage the public, the event was organised under a workshop format, where the participants could know about not only CLEANTEX project but also deepen into other sustainability issues. The session was planned as a dissemination and informative event, but also with an interactive part. During the morning, the projects' aims and objectives, the specific expected outputs and activities already carried out by the partners were explained. The EU contribution and support was also presented and analysed towards the participants, the cluster members, who are basically textile Catalan companies on advanced textile materials, innovation centres, institutions, Universities and other relevant stakeholders.

The event was moderated by Ariadna Detrell, Cluster Manager, and Marta Casadesús, Project Manager and AEI Tèxtils' staff in charge of the CLEANTEX project.

The event began with the presentation of the cluster's circular and sustainable initiatives by Ariadna Detrell. Then, it continued with Marta giving a general and complete overview of Cleantex from its beginning, current development to the final goals. Also, adding a specific description of the Intellectual Outputs that are currently under development. Particularly, about the results of the IO2, the bootcamp (the training developed by the consortium) and the e-book (the compilation of good sustainable and circularity practices within the textile sector).

Afterwards, Marta Casadesús exposed to all the assistants the advances and potential benefits for the technical textile sector in Catalonia.

Then, Marta deepened into the Intellectual Output 1, the virtual training program and the Intellectual Output 3, the virtual Hackathon Platform. The project manager detailed its functionalities, development and utilities for the project aims. The participation of some cluster's companies in the hackathon was also highlighted.

The session concluded with an interactive working session to identify potential future activities and services to improve the competitiveness of the advanced textile manufacturing companies.

The feedback received by the participants was very positive, as they considered the CLEANTEX project very valuable and interesting. The feedback was provided *in situ* and through the [questionnaire](#) facilitated by the project quality partner. Furthermore, what is more important is the knowledge obtained by the attendants about the importance between the design and the technical textile sector.
